About the job

We are looking for a data scientist with proficiency in analysis and interpretation of omics data with sound background in statistics, coding and a solid understanding of molecular biology. The successful candidate will contribute to the generation, integration and interpretation of various OMICs data including single cell (sc-) and bulk-RNaseq data to accelerate target identification, validation and biomarker discovery efforts that support our preclinical programs advancing toward clinical development.

Key Responsibilities:

- Support daily laboratory operations, including equipment maintenance, inventory management, and ensuring a clean and well-organized workspace.
- Prepare media, buffers, and reagents as needed for experimental work.
- Plan, perform, and analyse *in vitro* and *in vivo* experiments, contributing to ongoing research projects.
- Independently conduct experiments or subprojects following initial training and established procedures.
- Maintain accurate and detailed documentation of experimental procedures and results.
- Contribute to the implementation and optimization of new experimental methods and technologies.
